How the candle light works

First-time use: Turn the flickering candle on. Then charge the rechargeable battery (See instructions below).

To turn on the candle: Turn the black battery cap at the bottom of the candle clockwise until tight. To test if the candle is turned on during the day, place the candle in a dark room. The internal LED should switch on.

To charge the battery: The integrated solar panel is used to recharge the internal rechargeable battery when the candle is placed in direct sunlight. After 8 hours of sunlight exposure, maximum battery charge is achieved*. A fully charged battery will last up to 6 hours.

*Product performance will vary based on seasonality, geographic location and intensity of sunlight exposure.

To turn off the candle: Normally, no need to turn off the candle manually, it can turn off automatically (the built-in light sensor will automatically turn the candle off) at dawn or in a bright place. And if you want to switch off this candle temporarily, then just turn the black Battery Cap 1/2 turn counter clockwise.

To replace the battery: Replace the internal rechargeable battery when it will no longer recharge. This is normal for the battery as it reaches the end of its useful life.

To replace the battery:

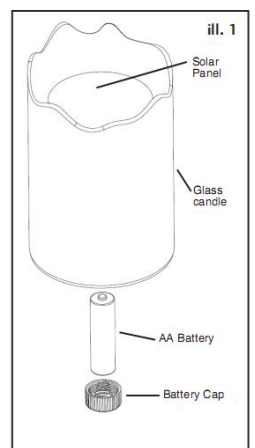
1. Turn the candle over.
2. Turn the black battery cap counter clockwise until it comes off.
3. Remove the battery from its compartment and replace it with one AA 1.2V 500mAH or greater rechargeable battery. Note: The negative (-) polarity of the battery should face the black Battery Cap.
4. Replace the black battery cap by turning it clockwise until tight.

CANDLE LIGHT MAINTENANCE AND CARE

- Clean with a damp soft cloth.
- Do not submerge the candle in water.

CAUTION

- Do not use the candle if the glass is cracked or chipped.
- Failure to insert the battery in the correct polarity, as indicated in the battery compartment, may shorten the life of the battery or cause the battery to leak.
- Do not use alkaline batteries. This unit was designed for use with AA rechargeable batteries only.
- Do not dispose of batteries in fire.
- Batteries should be recycled or disposed of as per manufacturer's recommendations.
